Membership is open to plant breeders and breeders' agents marketing varieties of cereals, oilseeds, pulses, potatoes, vegetables, sugar beet, fodder and forage crops and amenity grass in the UK.

Introduction. Farm-saved seed payments support continued investment in improved varieties, bred for UK conditions. Farmers are required by law to declare their use of farm-saved seed to BSPB, and to pay for the use of eligible varieties. Farmers should declare their farm-saved seed use to BSPB using any of the five methods below.

The BSPB is the representative body for the UK plant breeding industry. Formerly the Plant Royalty Bureau, the organisation was formed in 1966 after the UK Plant Varieties & Seeds Act 1964 established a legal framework for collecting seed royalties on protected varieties.
